

Zero Sort Recycling

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
Telephone Books; Soft and hard cover books
Direct Mail Envelopes (all types)
Paper (all colors – staples & paperclips are ok)
Paperboard (cereal/shoeboxes)
Cardboard, Brown Paper Bags
Milk/Juice Cartons, Milk Jugs
Food Containers (cottage cheese/margarine/yogurt)
Landscape Trays, Plastic Plant Pots
Laundry Baskets, Small Plastic Trash Bins (up to 5 gallon)

Plastic containers and bottles #1 through #7
Plastic clamshell containers (produce, take-out)
Soda/Juice/Water Bottles (glass or plastic)
Bleach/Detergent and Shampoo Bottles
Glass Bottles/Jars (any color)
Aluminum (pie plates/trays/foil)
Metal Cans (tin/steel/aluminum)
1 and 5 gallon buckets (handle attached OK)
Kitty Litter Buckets
Milk/Soda crates
Plastic Toys, Children's size Rigid Pools

NOT ACCEPTABLE

No plastic bags/film, plastic grocery bags, stretch wrap
No food waste
No foam packaging or Styrofoam

No ceramics, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, Pyrex
No recyclables containing food waste, paint, oils
No hazardous materials or universal waste
