The successful candidate will possess strong leadership skills with a proven ability to communicate effectively both in writing and verbally. Possess the ability to interact with the public and to represent the City of Brewer in a professional manner at all times. Familiarity with construction site safety requirements and a general understanding of water service line installation, or related construction practices. This position is expected to plan, organize, and motivate staff in order to execute projects and provide direct supervision for small work teams, sometimes on multiple job sites. Ensure accountability, professionalism, and quality of work for a variety of routine maintenance, emergency repairs, as well as planned system upgrades. Strong computer and record keeping skills are highly desirable and candidates should currently possess a valid Maine Grade III Treatment System License and Grade II Distribution System License from the State of Maine DHS Drinking Water Program, or the ability to obtain these licenses within 4-years of hire.
