

CITY OF BREWER 2017 SCHEDULE FOR THE FALL LEAF COLLECTION

The City of Brewer will be collecting bagged leaves this fall starting Monday, November 13, 2017. Only biodegradable bags will be collected curbside. Leaves in non-biodegradable bags or piled loose will not be picked up during the curbside leaf pickup. Large twigs, branches or trash mixed in with the bagged leaves will not be accepted; however, other small plants and garden waste may be mixed in with the leaves.

Leaves set curbside in biodegradable bags will be collected the week of November 13, 2017 starting on the north end of the City then working south. All residents should plan to have their bagged leaves curbside by Monday, November 13, 2017.

Program requirements and information:

Leaves must be in biodegradable bags and set curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Monday, November 13, 2017. Leaves in non-biodegradable plastic bags or piled loose **WILL NOT** be picked up curbside. While supplies last, biodegradable paper bags will be available for purchase (50¢ each) at the Brewer landfill on Elm St., Tuesday mornings 7:00am – 11:30am and the first and third Saturday of the month between 7:30am and 2:00pm.

Brewer residents may take their leaves to the Brewer landfill located on outer Elm Street, at no cost any time of the year during normal operating hours. The Brewer landfill is open every Tuesday morning from 7:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. (for leaves, brush, grass, garden waste & branches) along with the first and third Saturday of each month from 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. To make things more convenient for Brewer residents, the landfill will be open every Saturday from October 14th through November 18th from 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. for leaf and brush disposal. Residents may transport leaves to the landfill loose or in plastic or biodegradable paper bags but plastic bags must be torn open with just the leaves added to the compost pile.
