

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Bids are requested for the replacement of existing 8" ductile iron water main on Robinhood Drive for the City of Brewer Water Department. The water main will be replaced from the tee on Parkway South to the tee on Little John Lane. All hydrants will be replaced in their entirety.

The Contractor will be installing temporary water services to the homes on Robinhood Drive prior to the Contractor beginning their work. The temporary water installation must provide a minimum of 20 PSI to each home at peak flow. The Contractor will submit to the Brewer Water Department a temporary water plan showing a planned layout and design calculations. This project will be removing the existing line and constructing the new main in the same location. If less than 6' of cover exists, the new main will be lowered to meet the 6' minimum cover requirement.

The Contractor will be installing a new 8" ductile iron water main. All existing services are to be reconnected to the newly constructed main. The new main will be pressure tested and chlorinated prior to acceptance and the line being put into service. Contractor will be responsible for repaving the trench.

Interested bidders may obtain bid information and specifications for the project by contacting Brewer Water Department at (207) 989-4214. For consideration, the attached bid form must be sealed in an envelope, distinctly marked, "2020 Robinhood Drive Water Main Replacement" and must be received at the Office of Rodney Butler, Brewer Water Dept., 223 Green Point Road, Brewer, ME by 1:00 PM, Monday, March 23, 2020. Any bids received after the date and time specified will not be allowed. A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 1:00 pm, Tuesday, March 10, 2020 at Brewer Water Dept. located at 223 Green Point Road, Brewer, Maine.

The work shall not commence until such time as the Contractor receives a notice to proceed from the Water Department Superintendent or his designee. The work is expected to begin on or about April 20, 2020 and be completed October 2, 2020. The City of Brewer, Maine holds the exclusive right to reject or accept all or part of any or all bids received.
