The second open week will begin on **Tuesday April 21**st **through Friday April 24**th. Hours will be **7:30am to 3:00pm**.

The City will waive the traditional fees and landfill permits during this period. **The Landfill will be open to Brewer residents only.** Public Works crew members will ask to see drivers licenses at the gate, and will check each load for compliance to landfill rules. Be prepared to wait in line, as vehicles allowed in must adhere to CDC distancing guidelines.
