# Pine Tree Development Zones

## Program Snapshot

**Pine Tree Development Zone (PTDZ) program offers eligible businesses the chance to greatly reduce or virtually eliminate state taxes for up to ten years when they create new, quality jobs in certain business sectors, or move existing jobs in those sectors to Maine.**

Eligible sectors are:

- Biotechnology
- Aquaculture and Marine Technology
- Composite Materials Technology
- Environmental Technology
- Advanced Technologies for Forestry and Agriculture
- Manufacturing and Precision Manufacturing
- Information Technology
- Financial Services

**Depending on your business sector and location, your business may be eligible for:**

- Withholding tax reimbursements of 80%
- Sales and Use Tax for both personal and real property
- **Reduced electricity rates.**
- **Some financial sector companies may also be eligible for certain insurance tax credits.**
- **Corporate tax credit**
