NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Bids are requested for a resurfacing project with storm drain replacement and sidewalk and curb improvements on North Main Street in the City of Brewer.

The project includes a 1 ½" mill and fill of the main travel way and shoulders from curb to curb from Wilson Street to State Street. A failing section of brick sewer line will be replaced by 30" HDPE MaineDOT Option III dual wall pipe with a smooth interior. A doghouse manhole structure will be installed to make the connection between the new line and the existing brick storm drain. Some new curbing, mostly granite, will be installed in designated locations and sidewalk reconstruction will happen in select areas. Some areas of curb will be remove and reset with sidewalk reconstruction.

The storm drain work will be continued down Parker Street approximately 200' where it will be connected to an existing structure near Howard Street. All existing structures will need to be connected into this new storm drain line. Only 3" of binder pavement will be installed on this section of Parker Street because a future paving project will be completed shortly following this project.

A traffic control plan will be required for the storm drain replacement. The Contractor will have to submit the plan to the City of Brewer and DOT for approval. The Contractor will need to have a plan in place specifically for truck traffic. The Contractor will not be allowed to begin work until this plan has been approved.

For consideration, the attached bid form must be sealed in an envelope, distinctly marked, "2021 North Main Street Resurfacing Project" and must be received at the Office of Jeremy Caron, Brewer Engineering Dept., 221 Green Point Road, Brewer, ME by 1:00 PM, Monday May 3, 2021. Any bids received after the date and time specified will not be allowed. A pre-bid meeting will be held at 1:00 pm, Friday April 16, 2021 at the City of Brewer Public Works Department located at 221 Greenpoint Road, Brewer, Maine. All bid questions must be received by "three days prior to bid", all questions received after that time will not be answered. Bidders are advised, no seating will be made available for this meeting and masks will be required to be worn at all times. This meeting is non-mandatory and meeting minutes outlining all items discussed will be provided to all plan holder's, if a Contractor prefers not to attend.

Note that State of Maine prevailing wage rates apply to this project.

Prospective contractors should note that this project must be completed before October 1, 2021. The City of Brewer, Maine holds the exclusive right to reject or accept all or part of any or all bids received.
