





## City of Brewer Resident:

Maine State Housing Authority has created a federally funded program to help eligible Maine residents and renters pay their past due water and/or sewer bills. Residents and renters may be eligible for a payment of up to \$500 to be credited towards a current or future water/sewer bill. All payments will be made directly to the City of Brewer to be applied to the appropriate water/sewer account.

To be eligible for the Maine Water Assistance Program, the resident must pay for their own water and/or sewer services, be a homeowner or a renter (water/sewer cannot be included in the rent), and have an income less than the gross household income requirements below:

## Income Requirements 60% median income, based on household size

To apply, please complete the application attached to this letter. You must provide a current water/sewer bill or statement in the name of the applicant. You must also include proof of income and a copy of all household members' Social Security Card, Birth Certificate or Passport as proof of citizenship or documentation issued by USCIS as proof of qualified non-citizenship.
