INVITATION TO BID

City of Brewer (Buyer) invites Bidders to submit sealed Bids for the installation of a standby generator (Goods). The Contract generally consists of furnishing and delivery of the Goods to the Rooks Road Pump Station at 1269 Main Road, Eddington ME, with provision of Special Services by manufacturer's field service engineer and furnishing spare parts. Buyer will furnish a construction contractor under a separate contract to perform the installation or construction for which the Goods under this Contract are being furnished and to supervise and direct the Special Services being furnished under this Contract.

The Goods are to be delivered to the Point of Destination and ready for Buyer's receipt of delivery within 180 days after the date when the Contract Times commence to run.

The furnishing of Special Services to Buyer will commence in accordance with the approved construction schedule. The separate construction Contract is expected to be awarded in April 2024. A pre Bid conference will not be held.

Sealed Bids will be received until 1:00 p.m. local time on March 20, 2024 at Buyer's offices 223 Green Point Road, Brewer, Maine 04412. Bids will then and there be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the time of announced opening will not be accepted.
