NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Bids are requested for a resurfacing project with sidewalk and curb improvements on Elm Street in the City of Brewer.

The project on Elm Street (WIN #026053.07) includes a 1 ½" mill and fill of the main travel way and shoulders from curb to curb from South Main Street to a pavement joint prior to the railroad tracks (approximately 400' in total length). New slipform concrete curbing will be installed in designated locations and sidewalk reconstruction will happen in select areas. Two different curb molds will be used in different locations as specified in bid documents.

A traffic control plan will be required for paving and milling operations. The Contractor will have to submit the plan to the City of Brewer for approval. The City will permit southbound traffic to be detoured to Stone Street, if the contractor prefers to do that. Note: northbound traffic on Elm Street will not be allowed to detour to Stone Street. The contractor will need to show proposed signage on their plan and will be responsible for maintaining all signage during construction operations. The Contractor will not be allowed to begin work until this plan has been approved. The Contractor will be responsible for notifying the school department, City emergency services, and Community Connector bus service of the planned schedule of detour.

For consideration, the attached bid form must be sealed in an envelope, distinctly marked, "2024 Elm Street Resurfacing Project" and must be received at the Office of Jeremy Caron, Brewer Engineering Dept., 221 Green Point Road, Brewer, ME by 1:00 PM, Monday May 20, 2024. Any bids received after the date and time specified will not be allowed. All bid questions must be received by "three days prior to bid", all questions received after that time will not be answered.

Note that State of Maine prevailing wage rates apply to this project.

Prospective contractors should note that this project must be completed before September 20, 2024. The City of Brewer, Maine holds the exclusive right to reject or accept all or part of any or all bids received.
