The City of Brewer Public Works Departments is seeking bids for fuel island and tank repair as required to meet or exceed current Maine DEP requirements to extend our current license and, the replacement of the existing gas diesel pumps with new pumps compatible with the City's current fuel system.

Bids may be submitted in person, postal mail, or email; and shall be received no later than 12:30 PM on July 31st, 2024.

The City of Brewer reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to negotiate terms and conditions with any provider and to accept any proposal deemed, in its sole opinion, to be in the best interest of the customers of The City of Brewer, acting through its Public Works Department.

Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion

By submission of this proposal or contract, the prospective participant certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from doing business with any Federal department or agency. Furthermore, the prospective participant, if selected, agrees to ensure that any subcontractors it uses also meet this standard.

Proof of Corporate, Limited Liability Company or other Legal Entity Existence

The successful bidder shall provide the City an attested or authenticated proof of its legal existence to do business in the State of Maine.

Proof of liability insurance

The successful bidder shall provide the City of Brewer with a copy of its liability insurance naming City of Brewer as certificate holder.

Equal Opportunity

The City of Brewer is an Equal Opportunity Employer and Service Provider. The prospective participant, if selected, agrees that it shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, sex, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sexual orientation.

Minimum anticipated work required to satisfy current Maine DEP standards and pass inspection to extend City's fuel island permit to be performed by contractor:

- Mark site for DigSafe
- Sawcut, remove, and dispose of interstitial manway and associated concrete
- ❖ Furnish and install New 18" interstitial manway
- Concrete replacement of construction affected area
- ❖ Furnish and install New 14" manway lid
- Furnish and install (2) Overfill Prevention valves
- Furnish and install vent cap on 2" vent stack
- Disconnect and dispose 2 dispensers
- Furnish and install test boots on DSL and tighten boot on RNL
- Furnish and install test donuts on DSL piping sump
- Hydro testing of sumps
- Update AI and Hydro Test Report
- Install 2 new Gasboy Atlas Suction pump dispensers.
 - 1 for diesel and 1 for unleaded gasoline with 2 nozzles and 2 filters per dispenser
 - Make sure pumps are is fully functional and communicates properly with the City's existing Veeder-Root TLS-300C fuel system.
- * Complete all required paperwork for Maine DEP extension request on behalf of the City of Brewer.

Notes: Any work not specified above but is commonly required to perform work listed above will be considered incidental to the contract, thus performed by the selected contractor at no extra cost to the City. Any spill product cause by the performance of this work by the selected contractor shall be promptly and properly cleaned up and disposed of by the contractor at their cost and reported to Maine DEP if required. Damage to pavement surfaces required to perform the required work will be repaired by the others however, any unnecessary damage cause to pavement surfaces shall be deducted from the final cost of the contract at the rate of \$300 per ton, minimum 1 ton charge there after rounded to the nearest ½ ton.
