EMERGENCY PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, orders passed by the Brewer City Council do not become effective until five days after approval unless such orders contain emergency preambles; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to execute the contract by April 25 to secure the negotiated price; and

WHEREAS, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Charter, Codes and Ordinances of the City of Brewer and require that the following order become effective immediately upon its approval to protect the public health, common welfare and safety of the citizens of Brewer; and

WHEREAS, over the past three months the City Assessor of the City of Brewer has successfully completed a pilot of the C3 AI residential property appraisal platform, resulting in a 56% improvement in appraisal accuracy and a 19% increase in appraisal equity; and

WHEREAS, the platform has proven to significantly enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of daily assessment operations which would free up at least ninety working hours for the Assessing Office during a calendar year, earning strong endorsement from the City Assessor; and

WHEREAS, C3 AI, of Redwood City, California, has proposed a five-year subscription at a total cost of \$85,000 (or \$17,000 per year), which includes continued access to the existing deployed application, cloud hosting, data ingestion, and annual machine learning model tuning; and

WHEREAS, continuing use of the C3 AI platform will ensure fair, equitable, and technologically advanced property valuation practices, positioning the City of Brewer as a leader in data-driven municipal governance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, that the Brewer City Council, hereby authorizes the City Manager, or his designee, to execute a five-year contract with C3 AI for its residential property appraisal platform, in the amount of \$17,000 per year, for a total cost not to exceed \$85,000 over the life of the contract; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Council hereby authorizes the appropriation and expenditure of \$17,000 in unanticipated revenue in the Interest Earnings account (0105504-300400) to cover the cost of the first contract year, which is due and payable upon contract signing; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that costs associated with the annual subscription fees be charged to the Assessing Computer Software account (0115201-502300); and

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the City Council of the City of Brewer herewith exercises its authority under Section 404 of the City's Purchasing Ordinance, Chapter 36 of the Charter, Codes and Ordinances of the City of Brewer in the purchase of goods and supplies for this project.

Statement of Fact: This order authorizes a five-year contract with C3 AI for continued use of their residential property appraisal platform at a total cost of \$85,000. This platform has been demonstrated to significantly improve accuracy and equity in assessments and to enhance the efficiency of the City's Assessor operations.
