To whom it may concern,

The City of Brewer Water Department and Public Works Departments are seeking bids for providing No. 2 fuel oil for the 2024 - 2025 heating season, low sulfur on-road diesel fuel, gasoline, and propane. The term of the contract will be from July 01, 2025, through to June 30, 2026 and may be extended via mutual agreement.

Bid specifications have been enclosed for your convenience. Please submit your bid, attention to Thoma Noddin, 221 Green Point Road, Brewer, Maine 04412.

Bids may be submitted by mail or in person, and shall be received no later than 2:00 PM EST on June 26, 2025. Bids will be reviewed, and all bidders will be notified of the results, via phone or email, on or before June 30, 2025.

The quantities below are intended to aid in the bidding process based on historical usage and are in no way guarantees of quantity to be used or purchased, furthermore, there shall be no penalty imposed or variation in unit price should the City request more or less fuel than what has been estimated.

The heating fuel oil bid is to service 5 tanks covering 2 locations. Typically, automatic delivery will be scheduled during the winter months and delivery upon request the remainder of the year. Delivery tickets shall be submitted at the respective facilities following each delivery.

Please fill out a Standard Bid Form (see below) for each product bid, #2 heating fuel, low sulfur on-road diesel, gasoline, and propane.

It is the City's intent to treat all items included in this package for bid as separate items, therefore, each item may be awarded to separate bidders or all items may be awarded to one bidder. This will be solely at the City's discretion.

The City of Brewer reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to negotiate terms and conditions with any provider and to accept any proposal deemed, in its sole opinion, to be in the best interest of the customers of The City of Brewer, acting through its Water Department and Public Works Department.

Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, Ineligibility and Voluntary Exclusion

By submission of this proposal or contract, the prospective participant certifies that neither it nor its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from doing business with any Federal department or agency. Furthermore, the prospective participant, if selected, agrees to ensure that any subcontractors it uses also meet this standard.

The selected vendor(s) will be responsible for any spillage during delivery of said products, including prompt reporting to Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP) and the facility owner/representative; thorough cleanup of spill site; proper disposal of waste materials as a result of the cleanup; and any fines or penalties levied as a result of a product spill. Should a vendor utilize spill containment or cleanup material from the owner's facility, the vendor will be required to replace all such materials with new stock. Failure of a vendor to properly address spills as outline above will result in the facility owner taking charge of the spill and the vendor being held financially responsible for all cleanup efforts by the owner, a hired contractor, and (MDEP).

Proof of Corporate, Limited Liability Company or other Legal Entity Existence

The successful bidder shall provide the City an attested or authenticated proof of its legal existence to do business in the State of Maine.

Proof of liability insurance

The successful bidder shall provide the City of Brewer with a copy of its liability insurance naming City of Brewer as certificate holder.
