- Initial outreach to the Penobscot Nation has not yielded results.
 Honorariums requested were not feasible under current budget constraints.
- Ronny Baer's typical fee is around \$800; discussions ongoing.

2. Wreaths Across America (Susan Xirinachs)

- Letters ready to go out to donors from last year-
- End of August/beginning of September a second letter will go to potential donors for this year. Need to get a spreadsheet of possible donors from ?
- Fundraiser held at WM on June 28, raised just over \$256 cash as well as donations to come in from WM in future.
- WM Tractor trailer secured for 4th of July parade looking for volunteers to walk in the parade. Meet on Acme Road at 10:15 There will be a banner with the QR code, it is reusable and will be able to be used in future events. We can hand out wristbands,
- Our goal this year is 700 wreaths. 677 flags were place on Memorial Day
- Volunteer night will be held in the conference room in the auditorium so volunteers will know what to do and where the cemeteries are
- Possibly will be communicated in the weekly newsletter
- A new website for Brewer is coming out in September
- Susan shared the letter that is going to schools, explaining the contest.

3. Paws on the Penobscot Proposal

- Britney Ellis from the Animal Orphanage in Old Town, PR specialist
- Ten slots for vendors in Children's Garden
- We have space from just a little bit before Mason's, the Children's Garden, then just a little bit past.
- Under the trellis is where to have ten minutes to speak about topics such as grooming your dog, dog training. Probably have at least six ten-minute topics that can be covered.

- Dogs cannot come from the shelter but Brittany will bring posters of the animals that can be adopted, wanted signs for each of the dogs.
- Check with Eric to see if the walk can be on the whole waterfront.
- Talk of alternative spots, Washington Street Park or Maple Street may be alternatives
- Event timing, ending with Yappy hour event at Mason's start with the pet walk, fashion show, talent show, each of those can have a fee,
- Date- September 20
- People can bring donations of money or items for the shelter
- Area businesses have volunteered to put collection boxes in their businesses so people can donate
- PAWS committee will meet to iron out details Ashley, Tammy, and people from OT shelter
- Tammy will contact Environmental Services to talk about what happens when people leave their dog feces on the walks
- Tammy will go to the Brewer PUblic Library to schedule an appointment with Darren regarding donations being made there
- All donations will go to OT directly, a record will be kept by BCAC
- Tammy and Brittany will schedule a meeting
